Footnotes

SMARTEN DESTINY tracked the pace three wide, forged command with a furlong to run, dug in to meet the bid of SIR JOCK and was all out to prevail. SIR JOCK attended the pace along the inside, angled out for the final furlong, loomed large four wide but was unable to best the determined winner. COLD FEET disputed the pace three wide, opened clear on the turn, weakened during the drive but had enough left to safely hold the show. CHARLIE'S PHANTASY was allowed to settle, advanced between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. ROY L. was allowed to settle, came four wide but failed to make headway in the stretch. CHEAPER TO SETTLE saved ground to no avail. STORMIN HEDGES chased four wide for a half and dropped out.
