Footnotes

MISS CHEERS, lightly rated early while stalking the dueling leaders three or four wide, edged after EMILY'S ANGEL entering the stretch, caught that one leaving the eighth pole, was tapped once with the whip and concluded under hand urging. EMILY'S ANGEL went up to vie for the lead at once from the outside, dueled with PEACEFULL SAND, shook off that one, edged clear, then wasn't a match for MISS CHEERS in the final furlong. IDOL GIFT, outrun until the stretch while four wide, worked her way out six wide when straightened for the drive and offered a mild gain. MIMI'S GOLDEN GIRL, outrun for a half, made a mild bid in the upper stretch to reach contention but lacked a further response. PEACEFULL SAND contested the pace inside EMILY'S ANGEL for almost a half and weakened thereafter. IRONIC LADY saved ground but tired. SUDLEY SPRINGS followed the leaders in a striking position five wide into the stretch and flattened out. PROMISE ME MAGIC stumbled at the start and was outrun while five or six wide. LADY MONARCH was finished early along the inside.
