Footnotes

DIXIE TACTICS maneuvered near the inside early to vie for the lead, reached the front just prior to the end of the backstretch while dueling with BETTYBIRD, put that one away in the upper stretch and was going under hand urging to increase her advantage. MADAM ROCHAS, briefly in front after the start,was always well placed, raced near the inside and gamely earned second. RIVERMAN'S TEA, outrun until the stretch and five wide around the turn, came out eight wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. SIZZLING DISH, well placed three or four wide into the final furlong, came up empty. PRADO QUEEN, within striking distance throughout, while four or five wide, failed to rally. BETTYBIRD held a slight edge on the backstretch early while dueling outside of DIXIE TACTICS, surrendered the advantage to that one, continued close up into the lane and faltered. BAG OF STARS, five or six wide on the backstretch, came out nine or 10 wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. GOLDEN VIEW failed to threaten. SCRATCH OFF TICKET, bumped at the start, raced inside but faded nearing the stretch. NERISSA came out bumping SCRATCH OFF TICKET at the start, raced inside and was outrun.
