DYNAMIC, well placed in behind front-running MORGAN'S MAMBO (GB) from early on, moved four wide when advancing into the stretch, reached the front a furlong out and was hard ridden the remainder. MORGAN'S MAMBO (GB) gained the lead near the inside early, was headed by the winner nearing the final furlong and held on stubbornly the remainder. MISINFORMER tracked the pace four wide to the stretch and came up empty. PLAYSAMONGTHESTARS raced within easy striking distance to the stretch and flattened out. PARA VIDINHA broke slowly and badly to the inside, was checked, raced four wide while outrun to the lane, then passed tired foes. LADY COZZETTE tired upon going a half and wasn't abused at the end. After pulling up in distress on the backstretch, she was vanned off. WARNER'S SATIN showed nothing. CHARISMAGIC forced the pace for nearly a half, gave way and wasn't persevered with at the end.
