STARTLING BEAUTY sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, and stayed clear under steady urging. VIRTUOUSLY forwardly placed along the inside, moved out to the three path on the second turn but lodged only a mild late bid. IRISH WEDDING within striking distance off the rail, angled out to be four wide when rallying on the second turn and made a late gain. NOBILITY reserved off the inside, steadied and angled out midway through the second turn when rallying then made a late gain. LAST FULL MEASURE outrun for a half, raced four wide into the stretch and made a late gain. ACCENT reserved off the inside, made a belated bid. MAUDE S unhurried, steadied when carried out midway through the second turn then could not threaten. EJAY was outrun. HEARTBEAT AGAIN closest to the pace off the inside, faded. FIVE TIMES faded, vanned off.
