Footnotes

CONSCIENCE CLEAR gained the lead soon after the start, controlled the pace while under a light rating hold, settled into the final furlong with a clear advantage and concluded under solid hand urging. MAGICAL MIST, unhurried early while angled inside, continued along the inside most of the way and was fully extended to outfinished GOODNIGHT TRAIL for second. The latter, never far back, made a menacing run four or five wide nearing the stretch, was just off the winner for the final furlong but failed to respond. LOVE AN ANGEL drifted in at the start bumping SANCTITY, maneuvered inside, saved ground, made a run from between foes three or four wide to reach contention a furlong out but lacked a further account. SANCTITY, bumped at the start, angled to the inside, came out to advance between foes into the stretch and improved position. RECTORS CROSSROADS followed the leaders in a striking position five wide until the stretch and weakened. UNQUESTIONED, outrun until the stretch, swung out nine wide for the drive and failed to menace. SLATE CREEK stalked the leaders three or four wide until approaching the stretch and tired. INDEED I HOPE went up early to press the winner from the outside, held on well until nearing the final quarter and tired. DEPARTING DYNAMO gave way inside at the far turn.
