Footnotes

BET ON SUNSHINE, bumped from both sides soon after the start, settled while angled inside under patient handling, was unhurried for a half, uncorked a bold burst of speed about the five-sixteenths pole when swung out five or six wide, took over approaching the final sixteenth, then drew clear under hand urging in track record time. PROVEN CURE broke in front, settled within easy striking distance while racing three or four wide, moved with the winner while inside that one approaching the stretch, worked his way outside of BET ON SUNSHINE in the final sixteenth but wasn't good enough. SUN BULL, ridden a bit early to gain a position three wide, stalked the dueling leaders, took over and opened a clear advantage approaching the final furlong, then weakened. VALID BELFAST, outrun for a half, circled foes seven wide entering the stretch and found his best stride late. BET ME BEST drifted out at the start bumping the winner, assumed a slight edge during the early going, was displaced on the front-end from the inside by RUN JOHNNY, regained a slight edge before going a half but weakened in the drive. RUN JOHNNY was hustled along the inside to gain a narrow advantage before going a quarter, lost it on the turn to BET ME BEST and weakened in the drive. KIMBERLITE PIPE leaned in at the start bumping BET ON SUNSHINE, moved inside soon after, raced in contention until the final quarter and weakened.
