VALORY moved up at once to gain a slim lead, raced three or four wide while dueling with NASTY AND CRAFTY, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage, was tapped twice with the whip and ridden out late. JOISKI'S PRIZE, never far back, made a run five wide on the second turn, was just off the winner for the final furlong but couldn't threaten as second best. TORTINA (IRE), checked along the inside nearing the first turn, saved ground to the end of the backstretch, eased out five or six wide to reach contention as the field bunched approaching the stretch, moved five wide for the drive but couldn't menace the top two. R D FILLE, angled inside early, saved ground for six furlongs, came out seven wide for the drive and improved position while unable to seriously threaten. KISSIN SECRETARY tracked the leaders four wide into the stretch and tired. NASTY AND CRAFTY battled inside the winner for almost six furlongs and tired. INTRODUCER, forwardly placed near the inside between foes for six furlongs, tired thereafter. BOOM BOOM CHA CHA, outrun until the stretch, came out nine or 10 wide for the drive and failed to menace. HONEY MUSTARD GIRL stumbled in her second stride, raced five wide in a contending position for six furlongs and tired. CAJUN KITTY moved inside early but faded on the far turn.
