WHERE'S THE BEEF close up inside, angled out on the backstretch, challenged from the three path on the second turn and edged clear under steady urging. STINKING CREEK closest to the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, went with the winner after six furlongs, could not quite stay with the winner but was gamely second best. SAVAGE VOW reserved along the inside, lacked a closing bid. ARTILLERY bothered at the start, was reserved off the rail, angled out four wide when rallying on the second turn but could not threaten. COLBERT lost his footing at the start, drifted in after recovering bothering inner rivals, saved ground on the second turn, moved off the rail on the second turn and tired. NIEDERZEL outrun along the inside, found his best stride too late. GROOM OF DOOM bothered at the start, raced four wide on the first turn and was no threat. TITO within reach three wide, gave way. SERENASGO broke in the air, was outrun for six furlongs, came five wide into the stretch and could not menace. HIGH STAKES set the pace inside, responded willingly when challenged before a half, held on well to the stretch and faded. A. P. ELI lost his footing at the start, recovered to be close up three wide, but stopped.
