Footnotes

SEMIFINAL bobbled sharply at the start, settled in behind the leaders, moved out four or five wide for the drive, took over and won going away under mild urging. GRAY CACHE pressed front-running CLASSIC MOMENT from early on while three or four wide, gained a slight edge just prior to going a half, lost the advantage back to CLASSIC MOMENT at the quarter-mile ground, then continued on as second best while no threat to the winner. SINFULINDULGENCE tracked the leaders from early on while four or five wide and failed to rally. CLASSIC MOMENT gained the lead early, moved inside, was headed on the turn by GRAY CACHE, regained a slight edge but faltered in the drive. JIMANI, four or five wide most of the way, raced in a striking position into the final furlong and flattened out. MOODY KLAIR, five wide much of the way, was put to a drive concluding the turn but failed to respond. LIFE SAVIOR moved in three wide early and tired leaving the turn. SHELLY'S PRIDE, five wide while outrun, angled wider into the stretch and never menaced.
