**Footnotes**

VICKI VALLENCOURT, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, moved to challenge nearing the final furlong, gained the advantage, was brushed by SOURIS soon after, then came out bumping that one approaching the wire while capturing a narrow decision. SOURIS, within easy striking distance, was put to a drive five wide with three furlongs remaining, reached the front at the eighth pole while leaning in and brushing VICKI VALLENCOURT, lost the edge to that one, then was bumped and forced out by VICKI VALLENCOURT at the finish. ADOPTED DAUGHTER, never far back, raced six wide into the final furlong but lacked a closing bid. THAT'S OUR TRICKY sprinted clear inside early, made the pace into the stretch and weakened. JENNY'S PROSPECTOR chased the pace three or four wide to the stretch and tired. S'MORE SMOKE settled inside early, came out five wide for the stretch run but never menaced. MOLTO VITA stumbled at the start, quickly recovered raced in contention to the stretch while along the inside and tired. FOLLOWING A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF SOURIS AGAINST VICKIE VALLENCOURT FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE NEARING THE WIRE, STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED VICKI VALLENCOURT AND PLACED HER SECOND.
