Footnotes

SKRATE moved up inside early to gain the lead, drew well clear on the turn, then widened in the drive when under energetic hand encouragement. YASOW KERRI, outsprinted early, moved up four wide between foes for the drive, couldn't threaten the winner but gamely earned the place. WOULD YOU BE MINE, within striking distance four or five wide throughout, was just off the winner for the final furlong and came up empty. HEATHER'S LADY, outrun inside to the stretch, continued along the rail but lacked a late response. QUIZZLE, within striking distance and six wide into the lane, was empty late. LOVIN THE SUNSHINE, in front after the start, forced the pace four wide to the stretch and tired. ZILIA, bumped at the start and checked in tight quarters, was outrun for a half, came out six wide for the stretch run and improved position. SATINE ROUGE came out at the start bumping ZILIA and never was prominent. MELISSA'S LUV SONG contested the pace from between foes early, continued forwardly until nearing the stretch and tired. PATRIOTIC FEVER faded after a half.
