**Footnotes**

PAULA SMITH tracked the dueling leaders four wide from early on, continued in that position on the course entering the stretch and was fully extended to be along in time. PSYCH gained the lead near the inside early, dueled with BLACK TOPPER to the stretch, put that one away, edged clear, then failed to last. LADOMA, sluggish to start and shut off when LIVELY CLASSIC swerved in, advanced five wide into the stretch and was going well at the end. BLACK TOPPER, well placed in behind the leaders into the final furlong, failed to fire. DARBY'S CHARM, six wide while outsprinted early, remained well off the inside for the stretch run and improved position. LIVELY CLASSIC swerved in at the start and shut off LADOMA, was outrun to the lane and offered a mild gain. WOULD YOU BE MINE, outrun to the stretch, was maneuvered out 10 wide for the drive and lacked a serious response. SPURT, five or six wide most of the way, failed to rally. RADIANT AVIE dueled for the lead outside PSYCH four wide to the stretch and tired. FLYING FALCON faded leaving the turn.
