MOCHA QUEEN settled in behind horses early, raced three wide on the backstretch, moved closer to the inside on the turn, came around a tiring HARMONIC MISS entering the upper stretch, angled back to the hedge and drove clear late. VERY VEGAS pressed front-running HARMONIC MISS from early on while outside that one four wide, took over nearing the stretch, was clear for the last eighth and could not last. PRETTY JANE, outrun to the stretch, swung out seven wide for the drive and came with too little, too late. DIRTY RUSH, within striking distance throughout and five wide, lacked a late response. ANGEL TRUMPET tracked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. LADY DYNASTY had no rally. HARMONIC MISS gained the lead early, raced three wide, made the pace until nearing the final quarter and weakened. COUNTRY DIVA, off very slow while hopping, raced six wide and never menaced. STELLA BLUE (FR) never was prominent.
