COACH RYAN reserved along the inside, angled out for the drive, made a quick move to the leader inside the final furlong and drew clear late. THE DARP vied for the lead off the rail, drew clear into the stretch, could not cope with the winner late but held on to be second best. SINISTER outrun early, angled out for the drive and rallied belatedly on the outside. WAR RULER unhurried off the inside, angled out for the drive but lacked a closing bid. FIT FOR A FIGHT forwardly placed off the inside, tired in the drive. NIOBRARA close up along the inside, steadied entering the turn behind the leader, tracked the pace to the stretch then failed to respond in the final furlong. KNOCK OUT CAT lost his footing at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, was in tight between rivals in midstretch then tired. SIENA CANYON bobbled a bit at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed three wide but faded after a half. E Z PHONE HOME alternated for the lead along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and gave way. DR. NICK was no threat while in the four path.
