Footnotes

LA MILANESA stalked the pace three deep, launched her bid entering the stretch and was fully extended to wear down the determined ZISTER in the final strides. ZISTER opened clear to set the pace, dug in gamely to meet the challenge entering the stretch, but was unable to resist the winner late. CRUISIN'NTHEBRIDLE was allowed to settle into stride near the back of the pack, closed the gap from between horses through the second turn, wheeled out entering the stretch to be clear, finished with a surge and was gaining with every stride. QUEEN OF EMPIRE settled saving ground, shifted out with a quarter to run, split horses and was making up ground. SEALED BID was unhurried early, advanced from between horses, offered a mild bid entering the lane but weakened during the drive. CHAMPAGNE JANE was taken in hand at once and angled in to save ground, worked her way forward down the backstretch, was caught in tight and steadied near the seven-sixteenths marker losing ground, angled out to make a late rally entering the stretch but was left with too much to do. MIDDLEMARCH attended the pace four wide to the stretch, but faltered from between horses and faded. DREAM DATE DIVA was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and dropped out. FASOLA hopped at the start to get away slowly, made a middle move from between horses to range into contention, but came up empty entering the lane and faded fast. MLLE BALLERINA was hung wide while never far back, but tired after five furlongs and stopped.
