Footnotes

DECANTERING contested the pace along the inside, drifted out off of the rail inside the furlong marker, battled on with renewed vigor thereafter and gamely edged clear. HATHORS LEGACY tracked the pace four wide, launched a bold bid entering the stretch, poked her head in front a furlong out, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on fairly well to hold the place. HONOR HYMN contended between horses, settled off of the pace on the turn, angled out entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. CINDYRELLA was allowed to settle, veered in and hit the rail nearly unseating her jockey near the seven-sixteenths marker, saved ground thereafter and was never a factor. NURSE DONNA was unhurried early, was bumped and carried out entering the turn, steadied to avoid the downed jockey and showed little thereafter. MIS PARDNER RULES bobbled at the start, rushed up between horses to dispute the pace, was used up leaving the turn and dropped out. POLLARD'S BABE was forwardly placed between horses three deep, drifted out entering the turn, clipped heels and unseated her jockey at the seven-sixteenths pole.
