### Footnotes

WHY US stalked the pace five wide, launched a bold bid leaving the turn, collared FOREVER TANGO entering the stretch and was fully extended to wear that one down. FOREVER TANGO set the pressured pace three wide through the turn, then along the inside entering the stretch, battled through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way. AU DIXIE was unhurried into stride, swung five wide leaving the turn, drifted in through the drive and was along for the show. NOSHAMEINHERGAME made a middle move five wide to close the gap, but weakened entering the stretch. ANNIE ONE contended between horses to the stretch and faltered. HONEY C was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and faded. AMAZING SAINT contended between horses to the final furlong and retreated. CHROMATIC was away alertly and angled in to contest the pace, but came up empty before going six furlongs and dropped out. ELECTRA PALACE showed little.
