FUTURE PROSPECT chased the pace four wide into the stretch, then rallied to be up in time. GRAND TRAVERSE chased the pace, rallied and slipped through along the rail to take over in early stretch, edged to a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. NEW BAY showed speed off the rail into the stretch and gave way. SILVER CRAFT bumped hard at the start, chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. AWESOME ACT rated off the pace after breaking a step slowly, lacked a rally. DUBLIN failed to menace after being steadied when he broke out and bumped ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR soundly at the start. ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR steadied when knocked into SILVER CRAFT at the start, then was no factor while racing four wide. GRAND DADDY well placed early, raced along the rail and faltered. POSSE CAT saved ground and faded.
