**Footnotes**

DEVILLIOUS, in hand from early on while racing inside of pacesetter GO FOR PUDDIN, angled outside that one in the upper stretch, took over and was hard ridden then remainder. TIP ME OVER, unhurried early and saving ground into the stretch, angled four wide at the furlong grounds and finished willingly as second best. GO FOR PUDDIN gained the lead at the start, raced three wide under a rating hold, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. DE BERTIE, outrun for six furlongs and racing three or four wide, continued from that position on the track into the stretch and offered a mild gain. K. C.'S GIFT stalked the leaders four wide, was put to a drive concluding the second turn but was empty when straightened for the drive. ROYAL NO TRUMP, well placed three wide for six furlongs, weakened thereafter.
