Footnotes

LOVE TALKIN, in behind rivals early, was checked at the half-mile ground, continued inside, eased out four or five wide in the upper stretch and edged clear late under urging. GLOBALIZER gained a narrow lead inside early, dueled with STORM DANCER and INNOCENT REMARK, kicked clear into the upper stretch, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. TYPHOON BERTIE, within striking distance while racing near the inside into the stretch, was checked at the furlong grounds, angled out four or five wide and was gaining late. YES HONEY, outrun near the inside until the stretch, came out six or seven wide for the drive and offered a steady gain. UNFAZED moved in behind rivals on the backstretch, continued near the inside, was checked at the furlong grounds and lacked a late response. INNOCENT REMARK was sent up outside early, forced the pace three or four wide, gained even terms for the lead into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. OH MY LOVE, in behind rivals while outrun into the stretch, angled five wide at the furlong grounds but failed to respond. STORM DANCER vied for the lead between foes to the stretch and faltered. NO LITTLE ANGEL, forwardly placed in behind horses to the lane, faded in the drive.
