Footnotes

DOUBLE HALO gained a slim lead inside early while dueling with TRAPPINGS, shook off that one, settled into the lane with a clear advantage and was kept to her task. KITTY'S LEGEND drifted in at the start bumping with AS WE PLAY, was never far back while lightly rated three or four wide, moved up outside the winner in the late going but wasn't good enough. HIGH WIRE, never far back, moved near the inside leaving the backstretch, swung out five wide for the drive but was empty late. AS WE PLAY, bumped at the start by KITTY'S LEGEND, stalked the pace five wide into the stretch and came up empty. OUR JOSEPHINA, four or five wide early, moved inside after a half and failed to rally. DANISH FAIRYTALE (DEN) failed to offer a closing bid and was six or seven wide in the drive. WHATSTHELINE, badly outrun to the stretch, improved position inside. TRAPPINGS dueled for the lead to the end of the backstretch and tired. WOODMAVEN never was a factor. MANY PEARLS was finished early.
