SEA SIREN vied for the lead inside at once, gained a slight edge on the first turn while dueling inside of ESPLANADE, kicked clear upon going a half, repelled a challenge from EX CAELIS nearing the stretch and drew off in the late going under firm hand urging. ESPLANADE, briefly in front after the start while battling outside the winner, chased SEA SIREN four wide, fell back in the upper stretch, then came again to earn the place. EX CAELIS drifted in while breaking sluggishly and bumped WENDY'S ON TO ME, gained a position between horses in hand while three or four wide, moved to challenge nearing the stretch, was just off the winner and flattened out while drifting in and out a bit in the late going. HURRICANE ISABEL, six wide from the backstretch on, improved position but wasn't a threat. HUMOROUS GAL tracked the pace four wide to the stretch and came up empty. WUNDELIA (CHI) raced forwardly near the inside to the far turn and weakened. WENDY'S ON TO ME, bumped at the start by EX CAELIS, moved out five or six wide on the backstretch and tired on the far turn and was distanced.
