Footnotes

ITSALLBOUOTTHECHASE within striking distance, moved up three wide on the second turn, took over with a furlong to go and lasted late. ALMIGHTY SILVER angled in early, saved ground behind the leaders from the six furlong marker on, angled out to follow the winner once in the stretch and finished willingly to be gaining late. CITIZEN JOHN alternated for the lead off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. GRUENEWALD bumped hard at the start, was reserved for a half, raced off the inside on the second turn and could not threaten. MESSA NERA bumped at the start, vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. ROMNEY MARSH stumbled at the start, ducked in recovering soundly bumping GRUENEWALD and forcing that one into MESSA NERA, was outrun and never menaced. STRATOSTAR within striking distance three wide, moved out a path on the second turn and faded in the final quarter.
