MAAN rated off the pace, angled four wide on the turn, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, then edged away through the final sixteenth under urging. MOONRUSH chased the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command nearing the eighth pole, responded when MAAN moved to the fore, then weakened late and just saved the place. COLD FACTS allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn, angled out and closed well to just miss the place. OFFICER PRADO reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, eased out and closed with a belated rally. DISTORT THIS chased the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. ELUSIVE STORY showed speed along the rail to nearing the eighth pole, then tired. SEVE unhurried early, closed ground late without threatening. MINESTONE outrun after breaking poorly, failed to menace while gaining some ground in the drive. AWESOME'S ELEVEN off slowly, was not a factor. YES HE'S TROUBLE broke slowly, tracked the pace along the inside around the turn and faltered. GAMBLING DON showed little.
