GOOD JOURNEY, in hand early while in behind the leaders three or four wide, moved to the rail on the far turn, eased out six wide entering the upper stretch, was rapped three times in the drive left-handed, drifted out for a stride about the sixteenth pole and was going under solid hand urging in the final stages. MORLUC, in front after the start, surrendered the advantage to EVEN THE SCORE from the inside approaching the first turn, pressed that one four wide, reached the front again in the upper stretch, was briefly clear at the sixteenth pole but couldn't handle the winner late. EVEN THE SCORE broke in the air, recovered rapidly and moved to the front inside nearing the first turn, was engaged from the outside entering the stretch by MORLUC, then gradually weakened in the final furlong. TOUCH OF THE BLUES (FR), within striking distance throughout while between rivals three wide, offered no rally. ALY'S ALLEY followed the leaders in a contending position five or six wide into the stretch and came up empty. PYRUS tracked the leaders from early on while lightly rated four or five wide, continued forwardly until the stretch and weakened. STRUT THE STAGE, unhurried early and five wide to the stretch, came out seven wide for the drive but couldn't produce a closing account. DERNIER CROISE (FR) drifted out at the start bumping GRAMPAS, settled near the inside, raced in contention throughout and flattened out in the last eighth. GRAMPAS, bumped at the start, settled four or five wide, was outrun to the stretch, came out nine or 10 wide for the drive and never reached contention.
