Footnotes

CECELIA ROSE, well placed between foes early, moved four wide to take over entering the upper stretch, then was under brisk urging to draw off. LADIES PRECEPT, never far back while racing near the inside to the stretch, eased outside the winner four or five wide for the drive and couldn't menace late as second best. COIN TRICK, forwardly placed inside from early on, continued inside into the lane and improved position while not a threat to the winner. MARVEL gained the lead early, moved inside, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. RED ZINGER, between foes four or five wide, failed to rally. LOVE THE PRINCESS, near the inside while outrun for a half, came out five wide for the drive and improved position. SWEET ATTRACTION angled in early, stalked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. COLD ONE settled in hand four or five wide, raced between foes and failed to rally. NO SMALL WONDER, weakened after a half. BRIDAL GAL, seven or eight wide much of the way, never menaced. CHORUS GIRL wasn't a factor and was eight wide in the stretch run. KIWI GOLD raced five or six wide in contention for a half and tired.
