STORM IN THE LAKE rushed to the lead four wide, took over leaving the turn, and gamely edged clear through the drive. RATATAT tracked the pace three deep, launched his bid four wide, was unable to reach the winner but clearly prove best of the rest. SKY TOWN attended the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the turn and loomed a danger, but lacked the needed late response. HERP disputed the pace between horses through the turn, then along the inside to the final furlong, but weakened during the drive and gave way. JENNA'S LEMON was jostled between rivals at the start, made a belated gain four wide but failed to seriously threaten. AL RENADA hopped at the start, was allowed to settle, swung six wide to make a mild gain but was never a factor. HIS SONG was shuffled back entering the turn, went greenly in traffic losing ground and went evenly thereafter. KEEN CASE passed only his tiring rivals. DOINMYSONGNDANCE vied for the lead along the inside, was taken up inside the five-sixteenths pole, lugged in through the drive and steadily retreated. KING TING (IRE) was hustled along five wide in the second flight and was never a factor. KEENUS FROM LOUISA broke slowly, dropped far back and trailed throughout.
