Footnotes

TIZDEJAVU opened clear to dictate terms, widened the advantage entering the stretch and held safely through the drive. PUBLIC SPEAKER tracked the pace between horses, settled off of the pace a bit through the second turn, came again three deep and was getting to the winner late. INCA KING was forwardly placed three wide, battled gamely between horses through a prolonged drive, had the jockey lose the whip inside the sixteenth pole and just missed for the place. VEILED PROPHET settled saving ground, swung to the outside leaving the second turn and finished well. UNBRIDLE'S DREAM attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SKIPADATE was unhurried into stride, angled out to make his rally but found his best stride too late. WISE RIVER settled in hand, closed the gap through the second turn, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. MINE THAT BIRD dropped far back at once, angled out to make a belated gain but was never a factor. POP TARRT settled in the second flight, angled in leaving the second turn but went evenly. ATTEMPTED HUMOR was allowed to settle five wide and failed to respond.

DRIVING SNOW (GB) saved ground to no avail. BARYSHNIKOV chased the pace five wide to the second turn and tired. EUROEARS was close up three wide for six furlongs and faltered. ORTHODOX contended four wide for a half and stopped.
