Z. I. ZIPP opened clear to dictate terms, dug in gamely and was all out to narrowly prevail. FIVE STAR DAVID stalked the pace four wide, launched his bid entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. SHORE DO contended along the inside, made his bid along the hedge, lacked room through the drive and settled for a minor award. HAIL TO SHILOH was allowed to settle, came three wide to make a late rally and improved position. SOUTHERN REGION chased the pace three wide to the stretch and gave way. CLASSICAL CLOSING was hustled along four wide but weakened leaving the turn and faded. CELTIC NEW YEAR broke slowly, swung five wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. GEORGE RAY showed little. INTERCOASTAL broke slowly and never recovered.
