HOLIDAY TAP settled in hand toward the inside, angled out and commenced her bid circling five wide, reeled in OUTRAGEOUS inside the sixteenth pole and quickly drew clear. OUTRAGEOUS set the pressured pace along the inside, shook clear leaving the turn, widened the advantage through the upper stretch, kept on well but was no match for the winner late. SONNY BOYS GIRL pressed the pace four wide, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. SAFE was allowed to settle, came five wide and improved position through the stretch. TWO STEPPIN' TANGO settled into stride between rivals, closed the gap through the turn and offered a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. FILLAZZENE broke a step slow, moved up three wide for a contending position, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. JILL'S KITTEN was hustled along four wide while never far back, but faltered after six furlongs and dropped out. EMERALD GAL trailed.
