STAKES Firecracker H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$175 each, which should accompany the nomination. \$875 to pass the entry box; \$875 additional to start, with \$175,000 added. After payment of 1% of the added monies to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Sunday, June 26. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, June 18, 2011 with 55 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile.)

**Footnotes**

WISE DAN stalked the pace four wide, rallied to take over from STRIKE IMPACT nearing the eighth pole, then drew clear under pressure. BARYSHNIKOV allowed to settle, began advancing off the hedge around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while unable to gain on the winner. STRIKE IMPACT vied for the lead outside PLUTONIUM while well out in the course down the backstretch, angled in to continue contesting the pace with that rival three wide around the far turn, then weakened in the drive. MYSTIC reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals without threatening. LUBASH unhurried early, lacked a rally. PLUTONIUM vied for the lead along the inside to nearing the top of the stretch, then tired. GENERAL QUARTERS stalked the leaders off the hedge to the quarter pole and faltered. JOSHUA REYNOLDS was no factor while racing five wide. EL CABALLO raced four wide and was done early. OMNISCIENT rated in striking position off the pace, saved ground and faded.
