**Footnotes**

WINDSWEPT allowed to settle, raced three wide around the turn, angled even wider soon after entering the stretch, then finished full of run to be up in time. CHILLED tracked the pace, angled out and rallied to gain the lead in deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. BALLYCLOUGH showed speed along the inside, opened a clear lead in the stretch, made the pace to inside the sixteenth pole, then gave way. DREAM STEELER chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then closed to just miss the show while being outfinished by the top two. KARMA SHIELD tracked the leaders into the stretch and had no late response. ROTHKO chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. TROILUS failed to menace. MAJESTIC MAN dropped back early and was not a factor. FIFTH STREET was outrun. HOMETOWN LEGEND showed little. BOBBY S chased the early pace four wide into the turn and faded. RAISE THE BRIDLE broke through the gate prior to the start and was through after a half mile.
