Footnotes

FUNNY PROPOSITION showed speed off the rail, edged clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to hold off VOLCAT. The latter, bumped hard between rivals at the start, chased the winner three wide, was outmoved by that rival in early stretch, then responded to pressure and was gaining slowly at the finish. ILLEGALLY BLONDE outran after hesitating at the start, drifted to the inside in the stretch while closing well to be up for the show. ALWAYS HERE TOO reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed with a mild response. DOROTHY'S AURORA tracked the leaders three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. RUSTICANA unhurried after being steadied from close quarters at the start, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. TRASHY TALK chased the pace five wide to midway of the turn, then tired. SOUTHERN DRIFTER failed to menace. CURRAHEE ASSAULT bumped with VOLCAT at the start, chased the pace four wide around the turn and faltered. SWEET AND LOVELY was never a factor. KITISTAN tracked the leaders off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded. BODACIOUS BETS bumped hard with VOLCAT at the start, saved ground around the turn and dropped back.
