Footnotes

GOODTIMEHADBYALL chased the pace four wide, moved to take over approaching the quarter pole, responded when he lost the lead to ALSTOM in the stretch and came back on again under pressure to prevail. ALSTOM rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to gain a slim lead outside GOODTIMEHADBYALL nearing the eighth pole but was outgamed to the wire. WASHINGTON'S RULES unhurried while saving ground, angled out widest of all in the stretch and finished full of run to be up for the show. BLUEGRASS JAM outrun early, raced five wide around the turn, then closed well while being outfinished for the show. LOU BRISSIE reserved off the pace, eased out and finished willingly. GARRYOWEN chased the pace three wide around the

turn, then weakened. EXPECTING CASH chased the pace four wide to midway of the turn and gave way. LE MANS well placed racing along the rail, steadied approaching the quarter pole and failed to recover. SOUR failed to menace. JEANBAPTISTE COROT was not a factor. QUARTERMASTER was through after a half mile and vanned off after the finish. EDDIE'S BAND broke awkwardly, moved up quickly to set the pace off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faded.
