Footnotes

TIGER HUNT settled in behind horses early, raced three or four wide on the turn, advanced between rivals into the stretch, leaned in and bumped with ARCHIE B at the three-sixteenths pole, was bumped lightly by CHACHACHARLIE about the sixteenth pole when that one leaned in, then came out at the wire and bumped with that one under left-handed urging while proving best. CHACHACHARLIE swerved in at the start, gained the lead inside, managed a clear advantage into the final furlong, leaned in and bumped the winner a sixteenth out, then was bumped by TIGER HUNT approaching the wire. GETHSEMANI pressed front-running CHACHACHARLIE four wide into the stretch, loomed menacingly but couldn't muster the needed response. EXCITING METRO angled in five wide by the end of the backstretch, stalked the pace five wide the remainder and slowly was gaining. UNCLE WALTER drifted in at the start, bobbed and nearly clipped the heels of CHACHACHARLIE when that one swerved in, was outrun to the lane and unable to menace while slightly improving position. ARCHIE B drifted out at the start, raced close up inside, was bumped by CHACHACHARLIE at the three-sixteenths pole and faltered. SLADE, off slowly and checked in tight quarters, improved position but wasn't a threat. TARFU moved inside, raced in contention to the stretch and weakened. CORPORATE LADDER stalked the leaders five wide into the stretch and tired. SUAVE never was close. RAVADON was done early. HOT SPRINGS, eight wide on the backstretch, was always outrun. A foul claim lodged by the rider of CHACHACHARLIE against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was disallowed.
