Footnotes

TRIAL BY JURY, rated in behind the leaders from early on, moved between foes four wide on the far turn, gained commend entering the upper stretch and widened under strong handling. STRENGTH WITHIN, within striking distance always, moved six wide on the far turn, continued off the inside into the stretch and bested the others while no threat to the winner. PERMISO, well placed from the outset, gained a slim lead four wide on the backstretch, battled with the winner to the stretch and couldn't keep pace. JUSTLIKEDAWG, six wide from the first turn on, was between foes while edging closer nearing the stretch, continued well off the inside to make a run into the final furlong but couldn't continue. ADMIRAL SLEW drifted in at the start bumping GOLD CITY SLEW, was outrun to the far turn, reached contention in behind foes in the upper stretch but lacked a late response. IMPERIAL THEATRE (IRE), outrun for a half, made a run seven wide to reach contention concluding the backstretch, remained a factor into the upper stretch but flattened out. CUMULUS, in behind horses, was checked approaching the final quarter and failed to rally. SURREY, well placed while forcing the pace four wide, raced in contention to the final quarter and weakened. IRRAWADDY, well placed inside to the far turn, weakened thereafter. PROSPECT WON never was prominent. GOLD CITY SLEW, bumped from both sides at the start, rushed up soon after to force the pace, held on well until the end of the backstretch and tired. LARSON E WHIPSNAD E came out at the start bumping GOLD CITY SLEW, moved to the front soon after, angled inside, then gave way after six furlongs.
