### Footnotes

CHARISMATIC APPEAL, close up inside early, eased out three or four wide on the turn, took over in the upper stretch, opened a clear advantage and was kept to her task. PICK OF THE PACK came out at the start bumping FASHION GIRL, was outrun for a half, angled out six wide for the drive and was gaining late. BOONE'S DIAMOND sprinted to the front, edged inward, drew clear between calls on the turn but weakened in the stretch run. FIRST LADY (ARG) tracked the leaders four wide to the stretch and weakened. CAHILL HOLLY, within easy striking distance near the inside for a half, angled to the rail for the drive but was empty. FASHION GIRL, bumped at the start, raced in contention for a half while near the inside and faded.
