Footnotes

LENATAREESE settled three wide, maneuvered out six wide entering the upper stretch and was ridden hard to prevail. MOCHA QUEEN tracked the pace three or four wide from early on, had aim in the drive but wasn't good enough. AMANUENSIS, in contention from the start, moved between horses three wide to vie for the lead upon going a half, gained narrow edge between calls, was displaced a quarter-mile out, regained a slim advantage at the furlong grounds but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SILVER WENCH, close up from the outset, forced the pace three or four wide, gained a slim lead, battled into the final furlong and weakened slightly. THORNHILL, well placed in behind the leaders to the stretch, loomed between foes four wide for the final furlong and came up empty. CAROLINA ROSE, within striking distance five or six wide to the stretch, faltered in the drive. CHURCH AFFAIR gained a clear lead inside early, was displaced before going a half, then faded nearing the final quarter.
