Footnotes

DESERT GOLD, a forward factor between foes from early on, reached the front in the upper stretch, was engaged from the outside a sixteenth out by CHIRIMOYA, then outgamed that one the remainder. CHIRIMOYA, never far back while three wide, made a bold run five wide into the final furlong, gained even terms with the winner while outside that one and wasn't quite good enough. RUBYANA stalked the pace early while four wide, continued prominently into the final furlong and came up empty. INFORMATIVE STYLE gained the lead early while dueling outside of BLUE SKY BABY, gained a clear advantage, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. BLUE SKY BABY battled for the lead inside early but was finished before going a half. ALICE ROSE failed to rally. LUV U SARAH ducked out at the start when bobbling and bumped LITTLEFUSE, raced inside and never was prominent. LITTLEFUSE, bumped at the start and outsprinted, appeared to bobble nearing the end of the backstretch, was taken five wide, continued off the inside, then was pulled up lame inside the eighth pole.
