SPICE HOUSE vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear under pressure. DOUBLE OR NOTHING close up along the inside, angled out a bit in the stretch but had no late bid. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH outsprinted early while off the inside, angled out for the drive and closed well. STAR'S CLASSIC CAT forced the pace off the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and weakened. MAUI STORM within striking distance four wide, lacked a closing bid. BUCKY CAME HOME prompted the pace three wide and tired in the drive. PERRY broke slowly and was no factor. KASTORICAL was outrun.
