TITIA, lightly rated while tracking the dueling leaders four wide from early on, moved to the fore early on the second turn, moved clear, then was under intermittent urging to increase her advantage. SAPPHERE HILL went up soon after the start to vie for the lead outside of PETITE DIABLO, gained a slight edge, lost the advantage to the winner early on the second turn and was fully extended the remainder to save second over SOUTHERN AURA. The latter, within easy striking distance while following the leaders five wide, lacked a closing bid. FLAG TO FLAG, sluggish to start and angled in early, saved ground, improved position near the inside late but wasn't a threat. BAMAGA settled near the inside, came out seven wide concluding the second turn, reached contention a furlong out but lacked a further account. IRISH SPLICE raced three or four wide and tired on the second turn. DOUBLE SEA lunged out at the start, then bobbed and wasn't able to menace. AFTERNOON AMOUR saved ground but tired in the drive. DOT C C was through early. PETITE DIABLO contested the pace inside for a half, faded, then wasn't persevered with in the stretch run when hopelessly beaten.
