CASHIER'S DREAM gained the lead at the start, maneuvered inside while edging clear, repelled a bid from LAKESIDE CUP at the five-sixteenths pole, then edged away under solid hand urging in track record time. LAKESIDE CUP, in closest attendance to the winner from early on from the outside, offered an earnest bid at the five-sixteenths pole but couldn't sustain the needed momentum as second best. COLONIAL GLITTER drifted out at the start, moved up soon after to track the leaders four wide, continued in a striking position into the final furlong but came up empty. JOANIES BELLA, in a contending position while near the inside between foes into the stretch, held her position but couldn't menace. GONE BYE BYE, three or four wide throughout, failed to threaten. YES HONEY, bumped at the start, moved out five wide on the backstretch, made a mild run from that position on the track approaching the stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. TWIN SAILS drifted out at the start bumping YES YONEY, then tired on the turn while racing inside. WAR DRESS, sluggish to begin while drifting out, was checked, then never close.
