Footnotes

SWEET TRIP went up early to force the pace four wide, took over in the upper stretch, edged clear, then was fully extended to last. MYMICH drifted in at the start bumping JUDGE ME PRETTY, was outrun to the stretch while four wide, came wider to rally, angled in a bit and split foes three wide in deep stretch and missed. SPECIALITY attended the pace from between foes, continued close up into the final furlong and weakened. BOSTON TEA PARTY, always well placed while tracking the leaders four or five wide, was empty the last eighth. TENDER TRAP, outsprinted early, moved in behind horses, rallied four wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. STARTARETTE drifted in at the start, gained the lead, made the pace until the stretch while dueling and tired. DOVENOS, well placed between rivals four a half, weakened thereafter. JUDGE ME PRETTY, bumped at the start, raced along the inside and tired. MADDIE H. broke slowly, raced wide and was outrun. BELLE OF PERINTOWN bore in badly after the start, hit the portable rail leaving the chute, was taken wide soon after and never was close.
