OUR HALO, close up inside early, was eased back, saved ground for a half, came out five wide for the drive and was hard ridden to prevail. ISN'T IT FUN broke sharply, edged in a bit, made a sweeping five wide run into the stretch, gained even terms for the lead inside the winner nearing the final sixteenth but wasn't good enough. ACTION WEST, never far back and saving ground for a half, came out five wide at the furlong grounds but gained only slightly late. PEACHY AFTERNOON moved to the fore from between foes early, made the pace while dueling with MALIBU KAREN, shook off that one in the upper stretch but weakened late. BONEFIDE REASON, in behind horses early, came out six wide at the three-sixteenths pole, reached contention but lacked a late response. REGAL WAGER, outrun for a half, improved position but wasn't a threat. MALIBU KAREN vied for the lead outside PEACHY AFTERNOON into the stretch and tired. BEATY CREEK was used early forcing the pace. SKYLINE broke a step slow, was checked, then outrun. EVIL raced six or seven wide much of the way and faded upon going a half. PAPI'S PEST was outrun.
