Footnotes

GULF STORM, in hand while saving ground from early on, moved to the fore while continuing under wraps on the backstretch, drew clear in the upper stretch, then was under mild urging the remainder. KIM LOVES BUCKY, unhurried early, worked his way inside, made a bold bid in behind the winner leaving the eighth pole, angled outside GULF STORM late and wasn't good enough. BOREAS, within easy striking distance from early on while following the winner three wide, was just off that one for the final furlong and couldn't muster the needed response. WILLIAMS HALL, outrun for six furlongs while saving ground, commenced his run five wide on the second turn, came out eight or nine wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. BUTTON, bumped at the start and checked, was outrun to the far turn, made a run five or six wide to reach contention but failed to continue the surge. MCSPLINTER drifted out at the start bumping BUTTON, was checked, raced within striking distance, moved six wide nearing the stretch but flattened out when straightened for the drive. ADMIRABLE went up early to gain a slight lead, raced four or five wide, lost the advantage to the winner on the backstretch, then weakened gradually. HORN O' PLENTY saved ground but tired. EXULTANT went up to force the pace early while five wide, weakened on the second turn, bore out about the five-sixteenths pole and was finished. COURAGEOUS CAT was outrun and distanced when not persevered with.
