Footnotes

RHYTHM IN SHOES stalked the pace four or five wide from early on, advanced steadily into the lane and was ridden hard to be along in time. VICTOIRE BATAILLE went up to vie for the lead three wide early, took over on the backstretch, made the pace into deep stretch and couldn't last. ERHU, unhurried early and six or seven wide throughout, was slowly gaining at the end. ELLENS LUCKY STAR, never far back, made a run from between rivals four wide into the final furlong and offered a slight gain. SHOREY VILLAGE, outrun to he stretch, found her best stride late while between foes four or five wide. HIGH SPEED ACCESS, outrun to the stretch, swung out nine wide for the drive and offered a slight gain. ALWAYS DREAMING, within striking distance, was six wide into the lane and flattened out. PLUMLAKE LADY, sluggish to start, rushed up to stalk the dueling leaders four or five wide and faltered in the drive. PICK OF THE PACK tired near the inside. CROZET was outrun. DICK'S CHICK angled inside early and never menaced. SOBINKA (IRE) used along the inside the opening half while contesting the pace, continued forwardly to the stretch and tired.
