RARE ELEGANCE gained a slim lead early while maneuvering in three or four wide, shook off JILL INDY PULPIT in the upper stretch, then was kept to her task to hold sway. SUCHAPRETTYGIRL, never far back and five or six wide, moved wider into the stretch and was gaining at the end to earn the place. JILL INDY PULPIT tracked the pace five wide, ranged up outside the winner for the drive but wasn't good enough. PURE SYMMETRY attended the pace from early on while edging in between foes, raced forwardly for a half and weakened gradually. MAY NIGHT swerved in badly at the start, was checked hard, trailed for a half, came out eight wide for the drive and closed a late gap. QUEEN SOPHIE, outrun to the stretch, improved position but wasn't a serious threat. WHEN MO MONEY reached contention upon going a half and lacked a further response. SLEW MARKER, near the inside within striking distance, was steadied in tight at the five-sixteenths pole and weakened. BOLD REVIEW wasn't a factor. LOVE WALK raced forwardly inside until the final quarter and weakened. FOREST ALY drifted in at the start and was outrun. CELESTIAL PRINCESS, sluggish to start and squeezed back, was steadied and tired on the turn.
