Footnotes

SABATINI, sluggish to start, raced in behind horses, lacked room at the quarter-mile ground, split foes four wide in the upper stretch, then drove clear under left-handed urging. SISTER BAY, never far back and near the rail throughout, was fully extended to earn the place. WILDCAT FAN, up close between foes early, battled forwardly into the final furlong and couldn't produce the needed late response. SOUTHERN FLU, outrun for a half and near the rail, continued inside, lacked room between the eighth and sixteenth poles, angled four wide very late and improved position. TIDE RUNNER, never far back and five wide, was empty when the test came. GOLDEN KNOLLS gained the lead inside, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. BANDSTAND, within striking distance but five or six wide, flattened out in the drive. SUMNEYTOWN raced near the inside and never menaced. SHE'S A DEVIL SLEW settled three wide and failed to reach contention. YANKEES BLAST angled in early, forced the pace three wide for five furlongs and weakened.
