Footnotes

FANFARE tracked three deep, took over leaving the turn, shook clear and held safely. SOUL OF COMETE broke a step slow and was bumped, was unhurried into stride, moved up four wide through the turn, loomed a danger with a furlong to run, flattened during the drive but stayed on to earn the place. INFLICTION was allowed to settle, advanced between horses on the turn, tipped out five wide entering the stretch and continued on well to garner the show. KAROLA'S DANCE was unhurried into stride, angled out six wide entering the stretch and improved position. MISS BROWN SUGAR stumbled badly at the start, nearly unseated the jockey and lost the inside iron, had the rider regain the pedal before going a quarter, moved up between horses, came four wide but weakened in the final furlong. COUNTESS D'ORO showed speed along the inside to the stretch and faded. BANSHEE WARRIOR was close up three wide for a half and retreated. SHOE QUEEN saved ground to no avail. MIZ MINNIE MOON vied for the lead between horses for a half and stopped.
